



Managers and the PID Act

Managers have a key role under the *Public Interest Disclosures Act 2022*. You:

- can receive disclosures from staff you supervise
- must communicate reports received to a disclosure officer, and
- must not discuss reports you receive with anyone except a maker of the PID or a disclosure officer.

Make sure you can recognise information from a staff member that may be a public interest disclosure, and you are aware of what you need to do if you receive a PID.
