

# Speak up in the public interest

**If you have information about serious wrongdoing, you can do something about it.**

- You can speak up – your report may be a public interest disclosure.
- Speak to:
  - your manager
  - a disclosure officer for your agency (check your Public Interest Disclosure Policy)
  - a head of your agency
  - an integrity agency
  - a head of agency or a disclosure officer of another agency.
- Your agency will keep you up to date with what it will do with your disclosure.
- You will be protected from detrimental action.
