

# Speak up in the public interest

Do you provide services or exercise functions on behalf of a NSW government agency?

If yes,

- You are a public official for the purposes of the PID Act.
- You can report serious wrongdoing, and your report may be a public interest disclosure (PID).
- If you make a PID, you will be protected from detrimental action.

You can find out more by reading the public interest disclosures policy of the agency you are working for.

There will be contact details for disclosure officers in the agency in the policy.
