

Speaking up is everyone's business

Everyone has a role in reporting serious wrongdoing.

Did you know that if you are a:

- staff member or councillor of NSWALC, or a
- staff member, voting member or board member of a LALC

you can report serious wrongdoing by making a Public Interest Disclosure (PID).

The PID Act contains protections for PID makers.

What is serious wrongdoing?

There are 6 types of serious wrongdoing:

- corrupt conduct
- serious maladministration
- a government information contravention
- a privacy contravention
- a serious and substantial waste of public funding, and
- a local government pecuniary interest contravention.
